

CF Endurance Scholarship

There will be six (6) recipients of the CF Endurance Scholarship each year. Recipients receive a complimentary CF Endurance certification of their choice (does not include travel costs).

Requirements for Application:

In order to be eligible for the CF Endurance Scholarship, the applicant must be in between the ages of 15-19.

The applicant must be a Steve's Club athlete that trains at an official Local Club of the Steve's Club National Program, having trained there for at least six months prior to application, and must maintain a consistent presence at the affiliate.

VIDEO: Applicants must create a 3-6 minute video that answers the following questions:

- Full Name
- Age
- Location of their Steve's Club Local Program
- Their story (ie, how they found their Local Club, what it means to them, how long they've been there, why they keep coming back)
- What are their training goals? Nutrition goals? Life goals?
- Why do they want to attend a CF Endurance certification? The more detail the better!

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION: Applicants must also ask for a letter of recommendation from one of their Steve's Club trainers to accompany the video. The trainer should answer the following questions:

- What has your experience been so far with the applicant?
- How does he/she exhibit tenacity, courage, discipline, or another positive character trait?
- Why does he or she deserve the scholarship?

POST-CERTIFICATION SUMMARY: If the applicant is selected, he/she is expected to write a brief summary (or create a video) after attending the Certification, answering the following questions:

- How would you describe your experience attending the CrossFit Endurance Certification?
- What was one of the most interesting things you learned as part of the curriculum?

- What was something else you learned as part of receiving this Scholarship (could be something about yourself, about life, about the CrossFit community, etc.)?
- How do you plan to share your knowledge or pay it forward in some way?

Post-Certification Summary should be sent by to SCNP Program Director, Lee Knight (lee@stevesclub.org), within 2-weeks of attending the Certification.

Timing:

Applications can be submitted at any time during the year to the SCNP Program Director, Lee Knight (lee@stevesclub.org). The six spots are first come first served, starting January 1st.

Lee Knight, Steve Liberati, and Brian MacKenzie will review all applications and the recipient of the scholarship will be notified within 1 month of submitting the application.

If selected to receive the scholarship, the applicant is expected to select an upcoming CF Endurance Certification and email their top 3 preferences to SCNP Program Director (Lee Knight) recognizing travel costs are NOT included in this Scholarship.

The athlete has 15 months to redeem their complimentary Certification.

The Scholarship cannot be transferred to another person, and the same athlete cannot apply for it more than once.

All videos, text, and material created for the application becomes the property of Steve's Club National Program/CF Endurance and will likely be featured in marketing material to promote both programs.
